BOOTH EXHIBITS

Theme: "When a Granger Calls"

Booth space available for any junior community or Pomona Grange, and any State Grange Department. Space is limited, must pre-register with Superintendent by August 1st. Booth size is 8 ft wide x 4 ft deep. Coverings may be used.

Exhibits must be in place by Friday, September 3rd after 11:00 A.M. and before 7:00 P.M.

All exhibits must remain on display until 7:00 P.M. on Sunday, September 12th.

Judging will begin at 10:00 A.M. on Saturday, September 4th. The following basis for judging will be used for booth exhibits.

- Developing the Theme 20 points
- Creativity / Originality 20 points
- Promoting Grange30 points
- Overall Appearance 30 points

Ribbons and cash prizes will be awarded to the winners in the amounts:

A centerpiece that would be for the feast table of one of the seven degrees, using various symbolism, colors, etc. of represented degree. Although allowed and encouraged, flowers are not a requirement of this arrangement and may be artificial if used. Entries will be accepted Friday, September 3rd from 11:00 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. Judging will take place Saturday morning.

FLORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Theme: "Pitcher Perfect"

An arrangement of flowers using a pitcher as the container or accent. Containers will be judged as part of the overall display. Appropriate accessories will be allowed.

Prizes for the showing will be:

ARTS AND CRAFTS

Any handiwork done by a Grange member can be exhibited for judging. Suggested items include afghan, quilts, patchwork, crewel, crocheted items, needlepoint, stuffed toys, wall hangings, dolls, rugs, ceramics, counted cross stitch, plastic canvas, Christmas ornaments, woodcraft, etc.

PHOTOGRAPHY

A photograph of any subject may be exhibited for judging. The photograph may be no larger than an 8 x 10 or a panoramic is not to exceed 14 inches long. All photos must be mounted or framed, no glass allowed. A limit of 10 photos per exhibitor.
