RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The show will be governed by and run under the latest revised official show rules of the American Rabbit Breeders Association, Inc. All prizes will be awarded strictly in accordance with the National Standard of Perfection. Judges may withhold prizes if specimens are not of sufficient merit.
 2. All entries will use permanent ear number (tattoo) which must be entered on the entry blank.
 3. No refunds. Substitution - same breed, variety, class, and sex.
 4. Unhealthy animals will be excluded from the show and barn.
 5. All stock must be property of exhibitor.
 6. EXHIBITORS MUST BRING THEIR OWN FOOD AND WATER DISHES.
 7. No rabbits entered in fur class unless entered in regular class.
 8. No rabbits are to be handled or removed from any cage for any reason except with permission of the superintendent.
 9. Any stock for sale can be listed with the superintendent of the Rabbit Barn. 10% commission will be charged for any stock sold.
 10. The show reserves to it's superintendent the right to interpret, amend, or add to these rules.
 11. Those exhibitors entering 10 or more animals in the show, will receive a pass to the fair for the week. Any person wishing to join the Long Trail Rabbit Club or the American Rabbit Breeders Association, may do so by contacting the superintendent or any club member.
- Please call lucretia for specific rules on rabbits that will be on display during the entire Fair. If it is found that an animal or animals are being improperly cared for, you will be asked to take your animal off display. The decision to ask for an animal to be taken off display will be up to the Superintendent and/or Fair

Management.
